



Maintenance Medication Fulfillment Resources

As part of your prescription drug benefit plan through **Local 262**, you have two resources available to you for filling your maintenance medication prescriptions: ProAct Pharmacy Services and CanaRx. Both options allow for up to a three month supply of your medication(s) to be shipped directly to your home, but there are a few differences. Follow the guide below to understand the option that will best fit your needs.

PROACT PHARMACY SERVICES

ProAct Pharmacy Services

ProAct Pharmacy Services is a wholly owned subsidiary of ProAct and the sole mail order pharmacy located in New York state. Maintenance prescriptions, in up to a 90 day supply, can be filled and delivered directly to your door for the cost of your mail order pharmacy copay.



Use ProAct Pharmacy Services for your maintenance medication(s) when:

- You have just received a “new-to-you” prescription for a maintenance medication.
- You are taking a maintenance medication that is not listed on the attached CanaRx formulary.

Instructions:

- 1** You will need a new prescription from your doctor to begin using the mail service. Your doctor can e-scribe, call in, or fax your prescription to ProAct Pharmacy Services. You may also mail a prescription along with a completed profile form.
- 2** Call a Help Desk representative at **877-635-9545** to set up your home delivery profile and method of payment.
- 3** Your prescription will be filled and you will be charged the appropriate copay. ProAct Pharmacy Services will mail your medication(s) directly to your door.

Local262Rx

CanaRx

Approximately 350 *brand name* maintenance medications are available through ProAct’s international mail order partner, CanaRx. If your drug is available internationally, you are eligible to receive up to a 90 day supply at a \$0 copay.



Use CanaRx for your maintenance medication(s) when:

- You are taking a medication listed on the attached CanaRx formulary.
- After you have become treatment-experienced with your medication. *Note: “new-to-you” medications should first be filled domestically through ProAct Pharmacy Services.*

Instructions:

- 1** You will need a new prescription from your doctor to begin using the CanaRx service. Your doctor can mail in your enrollment form and prescription to Local262Rx – P.O. Box 44650, Detroit, Michigan, 48244. *OR* The information can be faxed directly to 1-866-715-6337.
- 2** Call CanaRx’s toll-free number at **866-893-6337** for any questions or concerns that you may have. Additional details are also available at www.Local262Rx.com.
- 3** Your initial prescription(s) will be filled and mailed directly to your door within 4 weeks.
